Day 1: Wednesday, July 1st, 2026 – DEPARTURE

PM Depart on your international flight to Tel Aviv

Day 2: Thursday, July 2nd, 2026 – BRUCHIM HA'BAIM: WELCOME TO ISRAEL

AM Pick up from Ben Gurion International Airport
Drive to Neot Kedumim
Visit Neot Kedumim, Israel's biblical reserve, where ancient texts come to life through olive groves, vineyards, and wild herbs. Take part in a tree-planting ceremony, a meaningful act of connection to the land and renewal
Opening Reflections: Setting intentions for our journey with Rabbi Friedman

OR An engaging arts workshop for kids at a local kibbutz, where they'll get to create with their hands, explore different materials, and experience the community's creative spirit

- Flights.
- Travel insurance.
- Tips to the tour guide and driver at your own discretion. The recommended tipping are as follows: tour guide driving a private car for up to 5 passengers: \$110 per touring day in total. Group of 5-9 passengers in a minibus with a separate driver: \$110 per day for the tour guide & \$80 per day for the driver. Group of 10–19 passengers or more: \$14 per participant per day for the tour guide & \$7 per participant per day for the driver.
- Transportation in evenings when dinner is on own.
- Amendments to the program: In the event that any sites, programs or meals etc. are added to the program, an additional fee may be required.
- Any guests at meals or activities.
- Personal extras: Items of personal nature such as laundry, wines, mineral water, beverages, coffee, tea, food other than the table d'hotel menu, passport and visa fees, insurance, and foreign port taxes, unless otherwise specified.

Cancellation Fees

Up to 89 days before your trip: Cancellation without a penalty, trip deposit is refundable.
90 days or less before your trip: The trip is non-refundable, 100% cancellation fee.

Hotel Accommodation

The trip price includes all hotel accommodations, in hotel rooms with private baths. Our standard is to provide the best available hotels while considering value. Although the level of the accommodations may differ slightly from hotel to hotel, we are committed to your comfort. Standard-size rooms are generally smaller outside of the US.
